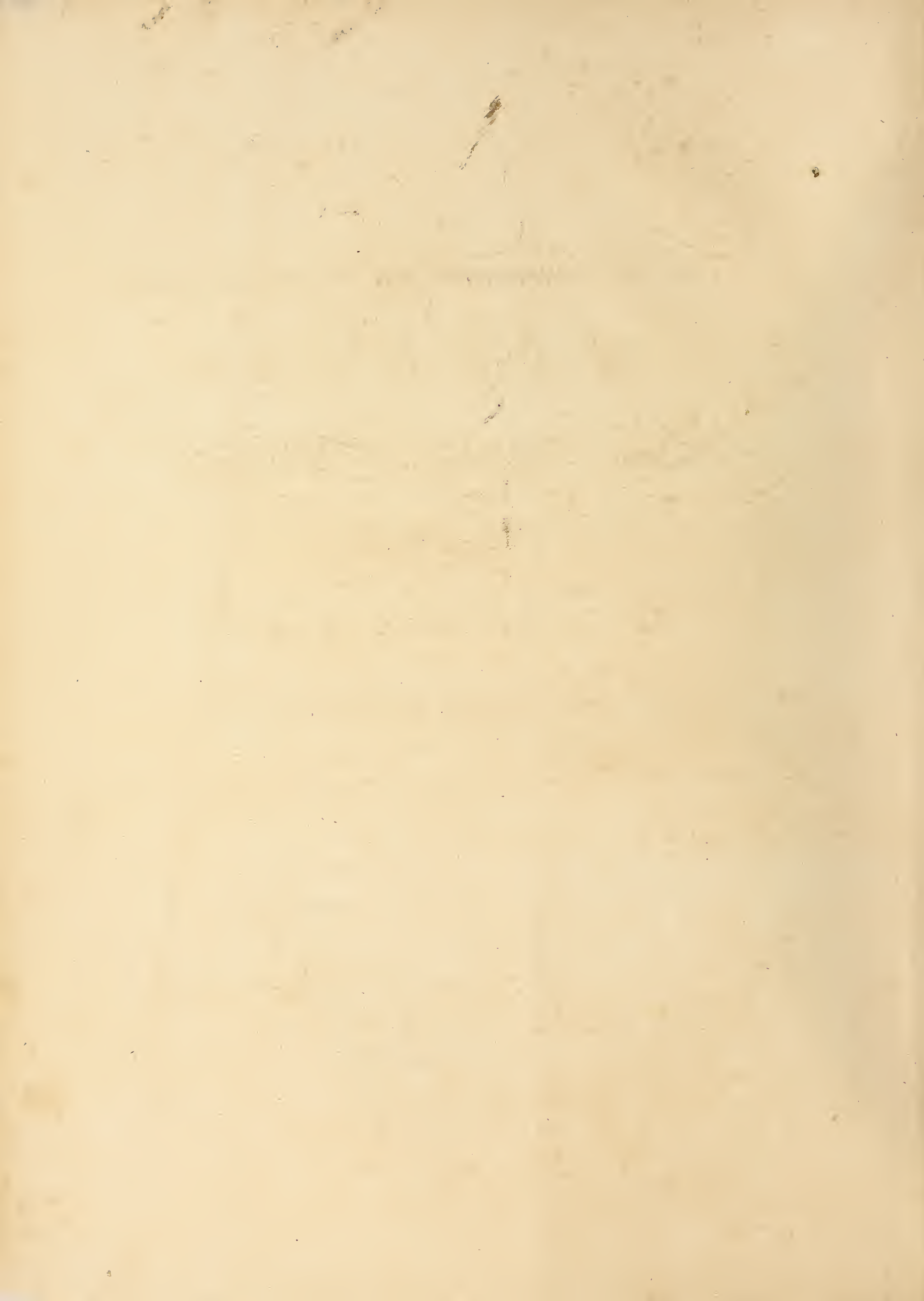

Whereas our trusty and well beloved JOHN GARTH, of *Durham*, hath, by his Petition, humbly presented unto us, That he has, with great Labour and Trouble, prepared a Musical Work, to be printed in Eight Volumes Folio, and intitled, *The First Fifty Psalms, set to Music by Benedetto Marcello Patrizio Veneto, and now adapted to the English Version by the said Petitioner*, with several other Pieces of Vocal and Instrumental Music; and hath therefore humbly besought Us to grant him Our Royal Privilege and Licence for the sole Printing and Publishing thereof for the Term of Fourteen Years: We being willing to give all due Encouragement to Works of this Nature, are graciously pleased to condescend to his Request; and We do therefore, by these Presents, so far as may be agreeable to the Statute in that Behalf made and provided, grant unto him, the said JOHN GARTH, his Executors, Administrators, and Assigns, Our Licence for the sole Printing and Publishing the said Work, for the Term of Fourteen Years, to be computed from the Date hereof; strictly forbidding all our Subjects within our Kingdoms and Dominions to reprint or abridge the same, either in the like or any other Volume or Volumes whatsoever; or to import, buy, vend, utter, or distribute any Copies thereof reprinted beyond the Seas, during the aforesaid Term of Fourteen Years, without the Consent or Approbation of the said JOHN GARTH, his Heirs, Executors, and Assigns, under their Hands and Seals first had and obtained, as they will answer the contrary at their Perils; whereof the Commissioners and other Officers of our Customs, the Master, Wardens, and Company of Stationers are to take Notice, that due Obedience may be rendered to Our Pleasure herein declared. P R E F A C E
T O T H E
O R I G I N A L W O R K .

THE present Work, which was begun under the auspicious Influence of the Divine Favour, has, by it's continued Guidance and Protection, been happily brought to a Conclusion. May it please the Almighty that both the Execution of Performers, and the Attention of it's Hearers, may be directed to no other End than that which the Authors propos'd to themselves when they undertook and compos'd it, viz. the Advancement of the Divine Honour and Glory. This End will readily be obtained, if, as the Authors in the Composition of the Work study'd nothing but to support and preserve the solemn Dignity of the Divine Materials, and to express the Sentiments in the best Manner they were able, so both the Performer and Hearer keep their Attention strictly fixed on the same Purpose, and the First expect not to reap the Fruit of extravagant and profane Applause, nor the Latter to be amused with the empty Blandishment of florid Conceits. Perhaps the Use of these harmonical and sacred Studies may afford no less Pleasure and Profit to the Professors of the Art, than the Madrigalish Compositions of Times past, (a Circumstance which would be highly mortifying to such as aim at Improvements in the Institutes of Music out of the received Practice) and should they even be found so imperfect as not to have equal Merit with Respect to the Advantage an intelligent Reader may receive from the Perusal of them, they will at least be sufficiently agreeable to the Piety of such Minds as inwardly cherish Sentiments of Humility and Devotion.

As the greater Part of the Interpreters and Expositors of Scripture agree in declaring the 22d Psalm to be a Prophecy and Figure of the Redeemer of the World expiring on the Cross, we thought it not improper, or rather absolutely necessary, to compose it for one Voice only, and in a Stile the most plaintive and best adapted to so mournful and interesting an Occasion: And in order to express it in the strongest Manner, and to awaken in the Hearers the deepest Sorrow it was possible from the Contemplation of this grand Mystery, we have given it an Accompaniment of Tenor Violins, an Instrument which (in the Hand of a Master) is of itself extremely well calculated for the Expression of tender and melancholy Strains. Let therefore the Performer who is to execute this Psalm, consider what it is he is to express and represent, and accordingly, rather with devout Tendernefs of Heart than artificial Flourishings of the Voice, pronounce it simply and distinctly; that every Hearer, as well from the solemn and mournful Sentiments, as the plaintive Melody in which they are express'd, may be affected with no small Degree of Sorrow, and sensibly experience some of those pungent Feelings which necessarily attend the Reflection on a Mystery so awful and affecting.

The Authors, sufficiently sensible of the great Difficulty of the Work and their own Want of Ability, undertook only the First Twenty-five Psalms, and had determined not to extend their Labours and Application to any greater Number; but finding their Work honour'd with the public Indulgence and Approbation in a Degree much superior to it's Merit, and being withal earnestly entreated to carry it further, they have (in Confidence of the Divine Favour, which has hitherto graciously attended and protected them) resolved to go on with the next Twenty-five, which shall be printed in the same Manner in other Four Volumes. May it please the Fountain of all Light to continue to illuminate their Mind with his Divine Ray, that this second Attempt may succeed as happily as the former, and so the whole of this arduous Undertaking, when conducted to its End, may not fail to have the happy Fortune to advance the Glory of the supreme Giver of all good Things, and to meet with the same Approbation with which in it's Beginning and Progress it has been so amply distinguished.
