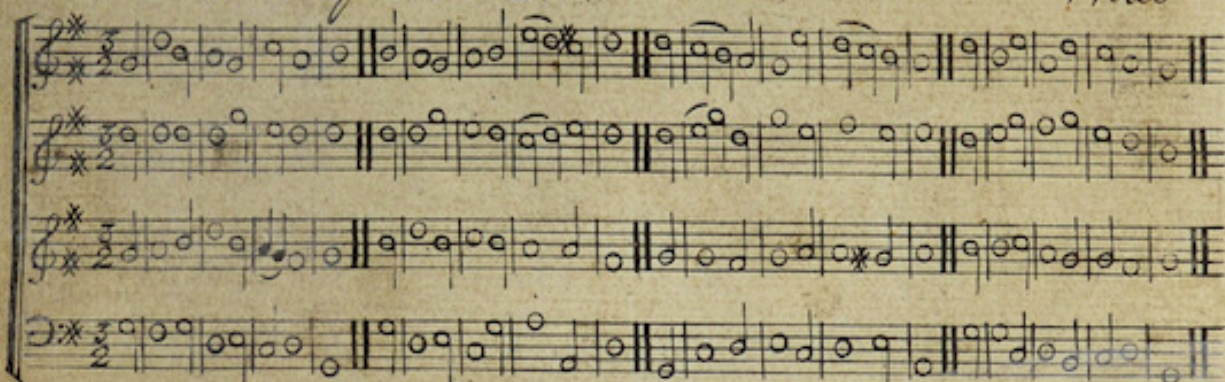


Psalm of 84th N. V.
